START TALKING | (Find a conversation starter for your group)

START EXPLORING | (Read the Bible)

START SHARING | (Choose a question to create openness)

- Why is the kingdom of God bigger and more important than our political system?
- What is our responsibility as believers when it comes to politics?
- Out of the "8 Ways Jesus Handled Disagreeable People," which one or two could you use in conversations about politics?

Start Praying. (Be bold and pray with power)

"Jesus, thank you for getting us. Getting me. Politics is so complicated. I want to want your kingdom more than I want my party to win. You came to invite and welcome everyone. So help me to love and engage in politics with a Christian influence and Christ-like attitude. It's in your name that I pray, amen."

Start Doing. (Commit to a step, and live it out this week)
