START TALKING | (Find a conversation starter for your group)

Read Psalm 127:1.

- Powerful verse! How does this speak to you?

START SHARING | (Choose a question to create openness)

- Of the three lessons learned in rebuilding, which one speaks to your current situation?
 1. God's people made financial contributions based on God's provision.
 2. God's people used their skills and abilities based on God's giftings.
 3. God's people experienced His love and His best.
- The main point of the message was where God guides God provides. How have you seen this truth play out in your life?
 - Any examples of encouragement?
- Go around your circle and share what God is asking you to rebuild in your life.
 - What are some next steps for you? Maybe your group can offer some ideas or feedback.
