## **START SHARING** | (Choose a question to create openness)

  - 1. God's people made financial contributions based on God's provision.
  - 2. God's people used their skills and abilities based on God's giftings.
  - 3. God's people experienced His love and His best.
- The main point of the message was where God guides God provides. How have you seen this truth play out in your life?
  - o Any examples of encouragement?
- Go around your circle and share what God is asking you to rebuild in your life.
  - What are some next steps for you? Maybe your group can offer some ideas or feedback.
