START TALKING | (Find a conversation starter for your group)

- Share a fond childhood memory you have of your parents or a significant adult.
 What makes this special for you?
- As a child, what was one lesson you were taught by an adult for which you are most grateful today?

START EXPLORING | (Read the Bible)

Read Deuteronomy 6:1-25

- Who and what are the commandments and decrees intended for?
 - Why such a strong emphasis on teaching these laws and decrees to children (v. 6-9, 20-25)?
- How would you characterize this method of teaching?
 - Why might this method be best suited to the task?
- What is the essence of the story recounted in verses 20-25?
 - What meaning does this story give to the commands and decrees?
 - With what results?

START SHARING | (Choose a question to create openness)

- How do you demonstrate your love for God?
 - How does this fulfill verse 5?
- What will you do today to demonstrate this love?
- Do you have more trouble recalling God's role in your life during times of failure, or in success?
 - How is this a reflection of Moses' fears in verses 10-16?
- In what ways is God responsible for the successes you enjoy in life?
 o How do you know this?
- How important is it to you that the children in your life grow up to celebrate God's love and appreciate his role in their life?
- How can you build traditions that teach them about God's love?

Start Praying. (Be bold and pray with power)

How can this group be praying for you this week?

Start Doing. (Commit to a step, and live it out this week)

Find a way to impact the life of a child this week (you could read them a Bible story, or tell them how Jesus changed you, or you could memorize a Bible verse with them).
