**START TALKING | (Find a conversation starter for your group)**

- What was one significant place in your formative years?
  - What do you like to tell others about that place?

**START EXPLORING | (Read the Bible)**

Read Joshua 4:1-9 and 20-24

- Why did Joshua have the people set up the monument?
- Why 12 stones?
- Why from the river?

**START SHARING | (Choose a question to create openness)**

Israel crossed the Jordan "on dry ground," but armed for war, signifying God delivers, but battles will follow.

- Are you battle-ready or battle-weary these days?
- What one life-changing encounter with God will you be sure to tell others?
- What "memorial" or other testimonial evidence would your co-workers, neighbors, or family come across which might prompt them to ask what God is doing in your life?
- Does your Small Group have a Jordan-like experience that could be "memorialized"?

**Start Praying. (Be bold and pray with power)**
