#### **DEFINITION:**

Gaining a thorough understanding of the content of a chapter in the Bible by looking carefully at each paragraph, sentence, and word in a detailed and systematic way.

## WHY

This method enables you to understand the Bible in the way in which it was written—in whole books.

Write Out a Caption



Circle the Key People, Places, and Words



Write Out the Major Lessons in the chapter



Choose a Lesson and Write Out what God is Speaking to You

#### **DEFINITION:**

Selecting a passage of Scripture and examining it in detail by asking questions, finding cross-references, and paraphrasing each verse.

## WHY

Allows you to have a more in-depth approach that requires a minimum amount of study tools.
